

Call for project proposals/application

The Rosa-Luxemburg-Stiftung Office in Greece accepts project proposals on the relevant topics (see below) solely by the following deadline¹:

- 15th October (for the following year)

Award decisions are made by the end of November.

The Rosa-Luxemburg-Stiftung is an internationally operating non-profit organization for political education affiliated with Germany's Left Party "Die Linke". Since 1990, the foundation has been committed to the analysis of social and political processes and developments worldwide, working in favor of a more just world system based on international solidarity. Our work seeks to support emancipatory political actors, and help forge alternative social models founded on democratic socialist values. Our vision for a future society rests on the full realization of democratic and social rights for all people, a socially just and ecologically sustainable global economic order, international solidarity and peace. Effectively, this will require overcoming the capitalist mode of production.

RLS Office in Greece is operating since 2012. Our aim is to empower civil society actors/activists, initiatives and networks, migrant organizations, social movements, actors from academia, intellectuals and the media, as well as left-wing organizations committed to political and social justice in Greece and Europe. Our projects range from research and critical analysis to public discussions and interventions and include various formats such as various publications and exhibitions, film, audio and podcast, multimedia and social media approaches, artwork, conferences, workshops etc.

Activities of the Rosa-Luxemburg-Stiftung Office in Greece currently relate to the following topics: Antifascism, antiracism and countering antisemitism, migration, critical analysis on EU-politics and economic alternatives, feminism and LGBTQI+ rights, Mediterranean cooperation and solidarity, history of the left and countering historical revisionism. Project proposals have to be submitted in English and should include:

A short description of the projects' concept, the target group and the goal of the project; a timeline and/or specification on the date(s) of the project activities; a detailed budget estimation; information about the organization/initiative/applicant and its relation to the RLS goals.
